Minutes of the Meeting of the Parish Council held on Tuesday 21 April 2015 at 7pm at Eccleston Village Hall, Kiln Lane

- Prayers: The Chairman welcomed everyone and opened the meeting with prayers for the 183 work of the Council.
- 184 Apologies: Councillor M McNulty
- 185 Declarations of Interest: No declarations were made.
- 186 Parish Matters: Cllr Bate reported large potholes in Hamilton Road. Resolved that Clerk would report to Highways Department of St Helens Council.

Cllr W Ashcroft informed the meeting of an event being held by Liverpool St Helens (LSH) Rugby Club. The Webb Ellis cup tour will travel the world arriving in England on 10 June and will embark on a 100 day nationwide tour. The cup will be on display at LSH on 28 July 2015 from 11am to 1pm. LSH (the oldest open rugby club in the world) will be staging a Tag Rugby Festival for 7 and 8 year old children. Every child competing will be presented with a medal to mark the occasion. Resolved that the Parish Council would contribute (under section 137) to the cost of the medals.

Cllr S Barton reported the uneven pavement on Kiln Lane, just passed the bridge. Clerk to report to St Helens Council.

Chairman, Cllr R Barton read out a letter from Cllr W Ashcroft informing the meeting of his intention not to stand for re-election on to the Parish Council at the forthcoming elections in May. In his letter, Cllr Ashcroft thanked fellow councillors both past and present for their support over the 20 years he had been a Parish Councillor. He also thanked Len Kilshaw, the previous Clerk, for all his hard work over the years. Cllr R Barton also read out a letter from Cllr S Bligh informing the meeting of his intention not to stand for re-election on to the Parish Council in May. In his letter, Cllr Bligh wished the Parish Council and Clerk well for the future. It was resolved that both Councillors would be invited to the next meeting of the Parish Council in order to formally thank them for their work.

- Lynton Way Play Area: An email had been received from St Helens Council informing the Parish Council that 2 new signs had been agreed for the play area. The Clerk to contact St Helens Council.
